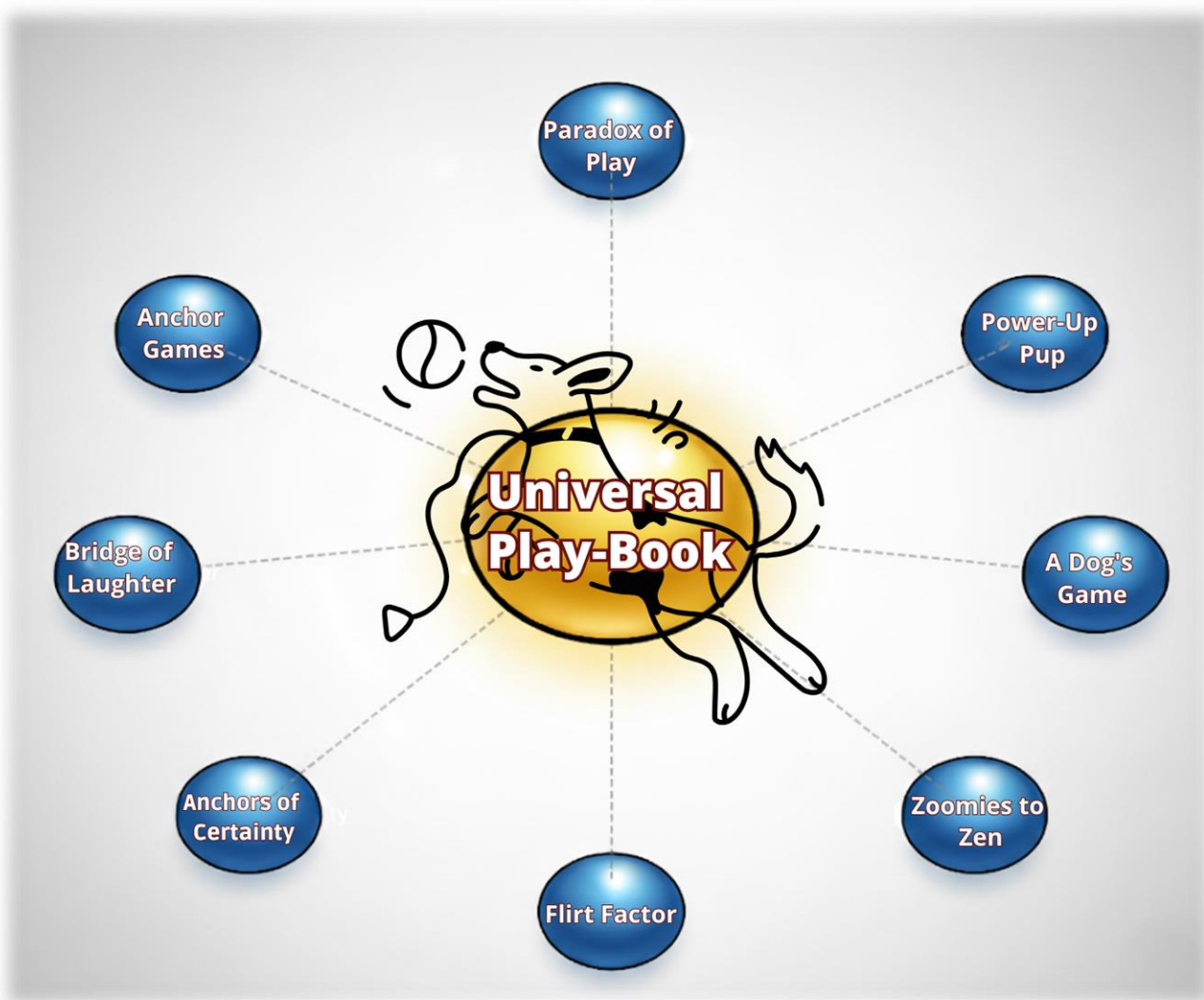




A Dog-Human Mini-Guide: The Universal Playbook

The Eight Pathways



The Paradox of Play

- Use **rainbow gradients** or multicolor splashes to emphasize silliness and unpredictability.

Power-Up Pup

- Lean into **neon effects**: electric blue, lime green, hot pink.
- Add a glow or lightning-bolt outline for visual “charge.”



A Dog's Game

- Give the dice a **retro arcade look** — saturated red, green, and blue.
- Add a 3D shadow so it looks like it's “rolling out” of the icon.



Zoomies to Zen

- Blend **chaotic warm tones (orange, red, yellow)** swirling into **cool calming tones (aqua, lavender)**.
- A swirl gradient can capture that transition from frenzy to calm.



The Flirt Factor

- Use **flirtatious pinks, purples, and fiery reds** with playful sparkle effects.
- Add a soft glow or motion blur around the figure to mimic movement.



Anchors of Certainty

- Go nautical: **deep navy, seafoam green, sandy beige**.



- Metallic or chrome-style anchor effect will give weight and reliability.



The Bridge of Laughter

- Imagine a bridge made of **bright, candy-like colors** (bubblegum pink, lemon yellow, sky blue).
- You could add a playful confetti pattern as a subtle background.



Anchor Games

- Style it like a **retro game controller**: pixel colors (cyan, magenta, yellow, green).
- Add a glowing grid or arcade aesthetic to tie in with the “rules + play” theme.
